Magnitude 9.0 Earthquake Hit Japan

On March 11th, 2011, an earthquake with magnitude 9.0 hit Japan. Cities like Tokyo, hundreds of miles away from the center of the earthquke, felt the strong shaking just a few minutes later. The earthquake was followed by a 7-meter high tsunami. The power of such a huge tsunami caused the most of loss of lives. The tsunami killed thousands of people when it washed away cars, ships, and homes. The tsunami almost knocked down a nuclear power plant in Fukushima. The cooling system of the power plant was damaged by the tsunami. People who lived close to the power plant were asked to move back at least 20 kilometers from it.

"The earthquake and the tsunami have caused heavy damages in wide areas in northern Japan," Prime Minister Naoto Kan said. The police reported "more than 8,000 people have been found dead and at least 10,000 are still missing. The number of the death would climb as they go on looking for the missing people."

Smartphone helps us in many ways, but they may also lead to many health problems and hurt our relationships.

Do you have the experience that your friend is just phubbing when you are talking to him? "Phub" is a new word to talk about the act of ignoring someone you are with but just focusing only on your smartphone. We can know more people through social media, such as Facebook, Line, and Instagram. And smartphone may help you stay in touch with family and friends around the world and meet dating partners. However, it doesn't mean that smartphones make human relationships much closer. In fact, when we get used to contacting people on phone, we might forget how to date and make friends in real life. It's probably happened to you at some point — the person you're on a date with looks at the phone more than at you.

Moreover, smartphone can also lead to a lot of health problems. Looking at screens for too long can hurt your eyes. This will not only make your eyes dry and sore, it could also hurt your vision. Your eyes aren't the only part of your body that could be hurt by the smartphones. People who keep texting messages with thumbs again and again can get an injury called "texting thumb." If you do it <u>ceaselessly</u>, it can make your thumb and wrist hurt. Using the phone too often lead to injuries which is not only on the body but also on the mind. Some people get their self-worth through social media's "likes" or "hearts". People keep checking on the phone to follow how many "likes" they get. Also, smartphones encourage the feeling of Fear Of Missing Out (FOMO). People who got FOMO can't help but check people's online photos again and again to make sure they don't lose any information or events. It will also make people feel that others are having more fun, living better lives, or experiencing better things than you are.

The smartphone has changed our lives for the better in some ways, but it still has its drawbacks, too. Putting smartphones away sometimes may be better towards your health and social relationships.
